

How does Málaga fit into itineraries? What is the importance of Malaga in the cruise industry?



Málaga is also a safe destination and complies with all security and sanitary requirements to guarantee a safe and pleasant stay to all the visitors in our city.

How does Málaga Cruise Port differentiate?

Málaga Cruise Port is part of the Global Ports Holding network of ports, the largest independent cruise port operator in the world, with 26 cruise ports in 14 countries.

Málaga Cruise Port has 16,000m2 of dedicated cruise facilities with dedicated piers for cruise ships. We are not a simple connection between the city and the ship: our facilities are the fist contact of the cruise passenger with our destination and here is where the experience and the holidays start for the cruise passenger.



Our terminals are designed to comply with full ISPS security code and health sanitary protocols, but also once the passenger stepped into our terminals they got immersed in Málaga, Andalusian destination: they can enjoy our modern Retail area with all local products and gastronomy testing coming to storytelling to the passenger that will guide them with the first ideas to start enjoying Málaga.

A wide range of services are also provided in our facilities, anything a passenger could demand, they can find it in our facilities, since a Guess information Center, to money exchange or transfer, any booking services or even to hire for a private translator service for the visit and also there is concierge service available along the whole call of the ship.

Málaga Cruise port facilities are very near to the city: the big terminals are walking distance to la Malagueta (the city beaches) and the Waterfront area and Pompidour Center (Muelle 1); terminal El Palmeral is right in the heart of the city center of Málaga in front of the Renaissance Cathedral. The whole promenade is surrounded in green with Olive Trees and some other native species of the Mediterranean Climate, a nice walking for passengers just in front of the beaches and far away enough from commercial port area. All dedicated cruise piers, next to the new Marina of Megayachs (Muelle 1) recently inaugurated.

Global Ports Holding signs San Juan Cruise Port

Global Ports Holding is pleased to announce that it has signed a 30-year concession agreement with the Puerto Rico Ports Authority for San Cruise Port, Puerto Rico, following a competitive procurement process managed by the Puerto Rico Public-Private Partnership Authority.

This agreement marks a significant development in GPH's strategic plans for the Caribbean. On completion, San Juan Cruise Port, which handled 1.8m unique passengers in 2019 (including c. 0.4m homeport passengers, i.e. 2.2m passenger movements), will become the third-largest cruise port in GPH's global network.

San Juan Cruise Port is a strategically important port in the Caribbean cruise market, perfectly positioned to be included in both Eastern Caribbean and Southern Caribbean itineraries. It offers cruise passengers world-class attractions and rich cultural experiences that can easily be done by walking across the piers. There is a magical blend of natural island charm that includes the verdant peaks, tropical forests, gleaming white-sand beaches, and man-made wonders. In addition, to its airport and hotel infrastructure, Puerto Rico is a US territory, which means it is an attractive homeport destination for Eastern & Southern Caribbean itineraries.









Port investment

San Juan Cruise Port is currently a popular transit port and homeport. However, its cruise port infrastructure needs significant investment to ensure continued operations over the term of the concession and to meet the needs of the modern and fast-growing cruise industry. Under the concession agreement terms, GPH will pay an upfront concession fee of \$75m to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority. During an initial investment phase, GPH will spend approximately \$100m, primarily focused on critical infrastructure repairs at Piers 1 and 4 and Pan American Piers, and upgrades of the terminal buildings and the walkway.

The second investment phase will commence subject to certain pre-agreed criteria, including cruise passenger volumes recovering to pre-pandemic levels. In this phase, GPH will invest an estimated \$250m in expanding the capacity of the cruise port by building a completely new cruise pier and state-ofthe-art homeport terminal capable of handling the world's largest cruise ships at Piers 11 and 12.

Improved experience

As well as investing in the port's infrastructure, GPH will invest in modernising the cruise port experience for cruise passengers, cruise lines and local vendors and will use its global expertise and operating model to improve the management of the cruise port operations. GPH will also invest in systems, equipment, and technology to enhance the cruise port's operational performance and ensure environmental protection, safety, and security.

The management approach of GPH will ensure the port is integrated into Old San Juan and Puerto Rico's thriving tourism sector as a whole, creating significant opportunities for local businesses to benefit directly from the improved facilities and the expected growth in cruise passenger volumes.

In addition, GPH's destination marketing team will work with the port management team and local stakeholders to ensure that cruise lines and passengers can enjoy the many unique attractions Puerto Rico offers.

A year of Milestones at Zadar Cruise Port

Zadar Cruise Port is fastest growing Croatian cruise port and since its opening in 2019, it has been continuously recognized for its service excellence, security protocols and highest level of operational standards.

The largest Croatian passenger terminal, purposely built for all sizes of cruise ship turnaround and transit operations, is one of the architectural landmarks of this area and the destination.

The 2022 has been without a doubt a year of milestones and celebration at Zadar Cruise Port.

Here are some of the most memorable events of 2022 season which will permanently stay in the port's history:

• the largest cruise ship ever to berth in Zadar - MSC Fantasia arrived on 2nd of May, and with her impressive length of 333m and 137,936 GRT, she is the largest cruise ship to ever berth in Zadar

- the most ships to berth at the same time - 3 large ships arrived on 16th of July. Costa Luminosa, MSC Armonia and Marella Explorer 2 simultaneously stayed at Zadar Cruise Port, with total berthing line of 786m and 230,720 GRT
- the biggest number of guests and crew in one day - on 28th of August there was 4,769 passengers and 1,457 crew members visiting the port, marking the day with the most guests and crew in one day this far
- the first turnaround operations Club Med 2 on 6th of August was the first ship to have complete turnaround, although MSC Armonia has had smaller embarkations and disembarkations throughout the 2022 season

Zadar Cruise Port started the cruise season in the end of February and it will continue until mid November 2022.









Crotone's Greek Heritage

Crotone and its province are located in one of the most fascinating territories of Calabria, in the southern tip of the Italian boot. The port of Crotone was born at the beginning of the eighth century BC, when the city was founded by Greek colonists as new polis of Magna Graecia and soon activated intense commercial exchanges with the motherland.

The port is divided into two areas, Old and New. The New Port, where the cruise terminal is located, is protected by a 1.725 m long breakwater and a 900 m long inner pier with a quay surface of 120.000 m^2 and depths of about 7,8 m.

Crotone Cruise Port manages the cruise terminal of Crotone offering transit, interporting and homeporting operations, as well as an increasingly wide range of ancillary services. Dedicated to small and medium sized ships, it is a hidden pearl in the heart of the Mediterranean Sea. Thanks to a mild climate, a rich hospitality system and a modern and efficient infrastructural network, the Ionian Calabria finally shows its beauties also to the cruise public, a new emerging star in the panorama of the ports of the Mediterranean Sea.

If you are visiting Crotone, you absolutely cannot miss these three must sees. The first one is the castle of Charles V, located almost in front of the cruise terminal. Symbol of the city, it is the seat of a section of the civic museum.

Leaving the city you can admire the sanctuary of Hera Lacinia from Capo Colonna, located on a promontory strategic for the control of the routes that joined Taranto to the Strait of Messina.

From here, you can easily reach Le Castella, one of the most beautiful stretches of the "Capo Rizzuto" Marine Protected Area. For sea lovers, welcome to the Calabrian paradise!

These awards nominations are brought by strong collaborations & work towards the development of the cruise activities in our ports & port cities.

Nassau Cruise Port's nomination drives from an environment initiative. NCP has placed environmental donation stations around its terminal to encourage passengers to leave their Bahamian bills or any donation amount to support local eco-friendly NGOs. Whereas Taranto has been shortlisted as the Destination of the Year. With a new terminal improved cruise and infrastructure, Taranto Cruise Port has been able to enjoy growing attention from the Cruise Line public. Following the 2020 shutdown due to the pandemic, Taranto hosted 28 calls in 2021, figure more than doubled in 2022, when 54 calls are reached. Although the season has not yet finished, forecasts already show an important growth also in the number of passengers, followed by that of the Cruise Lines: from the only one present in 2021 to the nine of the current season.





Forbes has chosen its ports that "have gotten it really right"!

It has named the terminals that don't detract from a city's beautiful, traditional character but, rather, add something to it. Whether it be an appealing shape, or architectural significance or, in one place, the ability to disappear altogether.

Global Ports Holding ports have been named as the most beautiful cruise terminals, inspiring other projects in the feature.

The 2 ports named were Valletta Cruise Port and Marina Bay Cruise Centre Singapore. Valletta Cruise Port has a waterfront, which won the European Union's Europa Award for Cultural Heritage, includes 19 warehouses built in the late Baroque period, in the 18th century, with colorful doors and window shades.

Whereas Marina Bay Cruise Centre Singapore is a structure that's meant to represent breaking waves and actually succeeds. Inside, it's light-flooded and decked out in the aquamarine shades of an underwater world. Outside, it's an appealing puzzle and an addition to the Singapore city.









Environmental Project in Nassau

July, NCP launched In early its environmental sustainability program under the theme, "It's in Our Hands," to establish and promote its commitment to environmental protection and awareness. The program was launched through the of announcement month-long а environmental awareness photo contest for Bahamians and residents aged 7 to 18.

The Nassau Cruise Port project, a \$300 million marine and upland transformation, includes several substantial eco-friendly elements including production of 1 MW of solar power to support local power provider distribution, full facility LED lighting, low water usage plans, full facility recycling plans, and incorporation of new green space into the downtown core.

Nassau has also placed a donation box in the NCP terminal building to encourage passengers to make a monetary donate to local environmental NGO programs.

More recently, we purchased a 25-foot boat to help us remove garbage from the harbour and to address any other environmental concerns.

On August 5, Seatrade Cruise announced that Nassau Cruise Port is a finalist in the Sustainability Initiative of the Year category for the Nassau Cruise Port Redevelopment Project.

New Spanish ports in the Canary Islands

("GPCI"), an 80:20 joint venture between GPH and our local partner Sepcan S.L., has successfully completed the competitive RFP process for three cruise ports in the Canary Islands: Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, Arrecife (Lanzarote) and Puerto del Rosario (Fuerteventura).

GPCI will invest approximately €40 million into constructing a new cruise terminal in Las Palmas and modular terminal facilities in Marmoles pier in Arrecife and Puerto del Rosario in Fuerteventura.

Global Ports Holding Chairman and CEO, Mehmet Kutman, said: "The addition of these ports to our network is a testament to the strength of GPH's proposition as the world's largest independent cruise port operator. We help create well-run, well-invested world-leading cruise port facilities for the benefit of all stakeholders.

Las Palmas, located in Mid Atlantic at the Canaries, is very popular for winter cruising thanks to the archipelago's mild climate. A major cruise port, Las Palmas is also a year-round destination thanks to its international air connections. With its sandy beaches and beautiful turquoise waters, Las Palmas brings together culture scenery.
